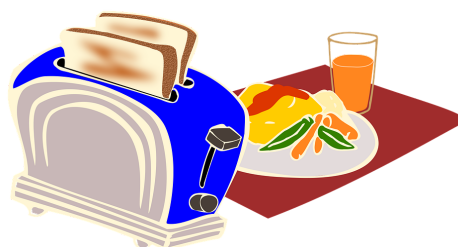
YOUTHTOWN
